Justification and Rationale of Mapping

PEO₁

To increase the program's robustness with a focus on experiential learning, strong emphasis is placed on project-based learning. The Institute conducts regular lectures by industry experts and practitioners (national and international level personnel). Field visits are given importance. Students are exposed to local and international industrial visits to understand local and global nuances. It conducts research project competitions and organizes seminars. This exposes the students to the practical application of their classroom learnings. They also use technological aids in their learning process.

The students are updated about the latest developments and trends in the industry through various add-on certifications courses conducted by the Institute. These are designed and organized to complement the enhancement of current requirements of the world of work. The faculty members of SFIMAR, through a diverse mix of pedagogy, deliver world-class education and help the students to acquaint themselves with contemporary business practices. Students learn the tools and techniques required to become global managers and entrepreneurs.

PEO₂

Entrepreneurial Initiative, 'Prerna Club' and Incubation Centre help to hone entrepreneurship skill sets among students. They instill a quest for innovation. The Institute is equipped with advanced technology - the latest computer systems, application software, 24x7 internet access, E-journals, projectors, smart class equipment, Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system, statistical software etc. This helps the students to develop techno-managerial skills required for decision-making and conducting research. The Institute faculty members encourage, motivate and facilitate the students to participate in inter and intra-collegiate competitions to display their creative ideas and entrepreneurial/ managerial skills. Events like Exuberance (an intercollegiate event), Anveshi (an intercollegiate student research paper presentation competition), Malay Club (creativity club), outbound training, etc., imbibe leadership skills in our students. Thus, they are prepared to take up leadership positions in organizations.

PEO 3

Ethics and value-based teaching have always been the crux of all pedagogies adopted at SFIMAR. The mission is communicated and delivered at all levels of activities conducted within and outside the campus. SFIMAR has an Institute Social Responsibility initiative - Abhimaan Club. The club conducts various social activities such as blood donation camp, walkathon to create awareness of organ donation, 'Say No to Plastic' campaign, visit to the orphanages, donations for flood relief, contributions to Indian Association for Blind, imparting life skill training to underprivileged children in association with Indian Development Foundation, etc. This fosters a sense of social consciousness among students. Another initiative of SFIMAR is the 'Green Club' that encourages students to undertake projects to promote a clean and green environment in and around SFIMAR. The Mindfulness Centre facilitates the development of SFIMARites to be mindful of social citizens. SFIMAR is also associated with the University of Mumbai for Lifelong Learning and Extension activities. Students are enrolled for extension projects and community support activities. They help the students to work selflessly towards a noble cause such as women empowerment, environment protection, child abuse, etc. A humanitarian attitude towards work and society is developed through the various activities of these centers. International Industrial visits sensitize a student about the social culture and ethics, and ethical business practices prevailing in the world. The guest sessions by industry experts and pedagogical tools such as role-plays and case studies make the students aware of the corporate world's ethical business practices and dilemmas. Initiating and implementing these activities enhance effective leadership and entrepreneurial skills in students. All outreach programmes create social consciousness. It also enables them to ignite the spirit of self-ownership, which enthuses them to take up their venture to become independent and capable of serving society at large.

Introduction

SFIMAR actively participates in DLLE activities to promote the values of human development among the students and provide a forum and place for the exchange of ideas, innovations related to social issues. In addition, the aim is to create social awareness and commitment among the students towards society.

The Institute has conducted activities like a visit to an orphanage, 'Prevention of child abuse workshop,' poster making competition on the relevant social issues like the role of women in modern society, save the environment, etc. Under DLLE activities college has organized `health checkup camps in association with Wockhardt Hospital for our students and people of surrounding areas. A cancer screening camp was also organized in association with HCG cancer hospital for the surrounding area. Our Institute has also hosted UDAAN, the annual fest of DLLE Mumbai University, twice in the last five years.

Objectives

Academic Year 2015 – 16

Entrepreneurship Skills Development Education Project

SFIMAR, affiliated with the University of Mumbai, is associated with the DLLE (Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension). The main aim of this program is to build a strong group of young people with discipline and character to make our society proud of them and develop the multifaceted personality of our students. Under this program, the students have to complete 120 hours, including E-learning and workshops related to developing entrepreneurial skills. The students are subdivided into a total of 8 groups managed by two student managers Deanne D'Sa and Vidhi Rathod.

DLLE Workshop for Faculty members and student managers was conducted on 27th August 2015. Student managers Brahat, Vidhi, and Deanne, have participated in this workshop. Usernames and passwords for the E-Learning portal were provided to student managers at this training program. The 2nd workshop was conducted on 31st October 2015. Student Managers Vidhi and Deanne participated in the workshop and the birthday celebration of Swami Vivekananda, conducted at the convocation hall of Mumbai University, Fort.

Entrepreneurship Skills Development Education - Sales activity report

As rightly said by the well-known entrepreneur Walt Disney, "The way to get started is to quit talking and begin doing." In this spirit, the DLLE entrepreneurship activity on 23rd October 2015 helped us overcome our risk-averse nature and provided us with a platform to set up our temporary retail outlet. The type of stall to be setup up was taken well in advance, and the students had to plan, organize, and cater to the needs of their target audience. This encouraged a wave of brainstorming and teamwork among the students. The respective groups managed each stall's investment entirely, and they were particularly cautious about the products and budgeting.

At 9 am, colorful and innovative charts were displayed at every counter. The stalls ranged from eatables to apparel. The eatables included Sandwiches, cupcakes, burgers, and sweets. Each item was so delicious that most of the stock was sold out by lunchtime. Some counters displayed trendy Indian wear for women as well as leatherware for men. The activity taught us how to manage risk and to work with limited budgets for a short period. They also learned how to multitask and allocate work according to the strengths and weaknesses of the team members. The sales and profit margins boosted our morale. Overall, the activity was a great learning experience, and it helped us 'young entrepreneurs' sharpen our managerial skills.

Poster Making Competition

Population Education Club Project - Workshop on Safeguarding Children from Unsafe touch

This workshop was conducted at Rustomjee School at 3:00 pm on 25th January 2016. The workshop was conducted for 120 children in total, divided into 30 children per class. Many children fall prey to sexual abuse by adults and sometimes older children. Many (15-20%) of adults report that children were abused or inappropriately touched. Children from all socioeconomic classes are affected. This experience can leave intense emotional scars on children and affect their development as happy, healthy adults. This workshop aimed to educate children about safe/good and unsafe/bad touch. They also educated children about three body parts (chest, bottom, and between legs) that anyone cannot touch. They also taught them how to protect themselves if such a thing happens. All in all, it was a pleasant experience interacting with the children and teaching them how to stay safe.



- It made our students and the surrounding community aware of the importance of donating blood. Furthermore, how it can save someone's life.




















Visit to Swagat Daya Ashram, Haloli on 01st December 2015

- It creates awareness about AIDS among people.










Walkathon in association with Zonal Transplant Coordination Center (ZTCC, Mumbai) on 3^{rd} February 2018

Green Club

Introduction

SFIMAR Green Club empowers students to participate in meaningful environmental activities like tree plantation, awareness drives and knowledge development related to social entrepreneurship for management students. It is a forum through which students can influence and engage their parents and neighborhood communities to promote good environmental behavior. It will empower students to explore environmental concepts and actions beyond the confines of a syllabus or curriculum. While everyone asserts the importance of 'learning to live sustainably,' environment remains a peripheral issue.

The details of a few of the activities undertaken by the club are enumerated below-

Activity 1: Tree Plantation

Objectives

- 1. To develop the closeness/connection to nature and love for Mother Earth
- 2. To understand the importance of care for the environment and giving back to the society

Practice

St Francis Institute of Management & Research (SFIMAR) propagates sustainable ways in all the practices within the campus.

- In 2016 medicinal plants were planted. Medicinal trees Plantation was organized on 1st
 July 2016. Trees like Tulsi, Neem, Aloe Vera, Gotu Kola, Lemon Grass, Khus etc., were
 planted.
- In 2017 around 100 saplings were planted (including floral and ornamental plants for beautification)
- In July 2018, approximately 50 saplings were planted within the campus.
- Due to heavy rainfall and soil erosion, few plants did not survive, replaced by the saplings donated by students in 2019. SFIMAR Green Club members discussed and decided to carry out a research study on the hydroponic system of cropping on a practical note. The project aimed to establish organic vegetable cultivation using a hydroponic cropping technique on a small scale in about 200 to 300 square feet of land. The project concentrated on cultivating vegetable crops/green leaves using mineral nutrients solutions, in water, without soils. Students of the 2019-21 batch took the initiative and cultivated spinach on the campus.
- During the lockdown period in 2020, proper care of saplings was not feasible, which led to
 further damage, but the institute took immediate action post lockdown to improve the
 situation. Beautification was done in the front part of the institute. Also, because of
 lockdown, the hydroponic initiative was stopped. Later rose saplings were planted in that
 area.

Students and the campus supervisor nurtured the plants by taking periodic measurements of the plants and providing timely fertilizers. It has been a regular ritual in SFIMAR for the students to water and interacts with the plants. Also, the students have initiated to donate saplings for the college campus every year.

Learning Outcome

Students learned to take responsibility by caring for the plants, gained leadership and teamwork skills, care for nature and the environment, and developed self-confidence.

Roles and Responsibilities

Faculty and staff members who are part of the campus Cleanliness and Hygiene Committee are expected to observe and correct any ignorant behavior that will adversely impact campus cleanliness. The maintenance department head is expected to ensure his staff clean the campus with appropriate frequency. If any periodic requirement, e.g., Toilet soap, comes up, he is expected to fulfill it with approvals. The chief coordinator is responsible for the overall maintenance of the campus.




